What's New in Version 6.0

Directory Sync Pro 6.0 introduces a completely redesigned browser-based interface. The new interface steps the user through the process of creating migration profiles and managing synchronizations.

Release Notes 6.0

The following features have been added in this release (tracking numbers are in parenthesis):

- The user Interface has been redesigned to include user-friendly wizards to create migration profiles.
 - The new browser-based interface also includes a profile dashboard to provide an easy way to edit profiles and manage synchronizations.
 - Repush, repull, and repush pull have been removed from the User Interface and are only available from the command line.
 - Overrides can now be exported, edited, and imported to the product.
 - Mappings can now be exported, edited, and imported to replace the current mappings.

- The Directory Sync Pro Help Center can be accessed by clicking "Help" from the side menu. (41104)
- The ability to synchronize Group Membership based on the member object's renamed sAMAccountName in the target domain per collision rename has been added. (33526)
- The option to not create empty OUs has been added. (33816)
- The ability to create a Windows Server Migration Profile has been removed from the Directory Sync Pro user interface. This product is no longer available. (33873)
- The Match Only option has been added for Domino to AD profiles. (34582)
- The installer now creates a local group on the Directory Sync Pro server named BDirSyncPro and will add the currently logged in user to the group. (36868)
- The ability to reset Overrides has been added. (39382)
- All-in-one configurations where the Directory Sync Pro console and the AD service is running on the Domino server is no longer supported. (39847)
- During a sync, Service Connection Points (SCPs) are now updated for existing computer objects that have been previously created in the target. (45821)
- Directory Sync Pro has been certified to work with Active Directory Domain and Forest Functional Levels 2003, 2008, 2008 R2, and 2016. (46917)

The following defects have been resolved in this release (tracking numbers are in parenthesis):

- An issue where the User Collision Rename option did not rename the commonName or userPrincipalName has been resolved. (19195)
- An issue where groups with multiple display names in Domino would prevent the group from synchronizing to Active Directory has been resolved. (35509)
- An issue where the synchronization process and the PDC Emulator discovery process occurring at the same time resulted in an incorrect PDC Emulator value and synchronization error has been resolved. (37813)
- An issue where Legacy Exchange DN was not being created for external contacts in On-Prem environments has been resolved. (38913)
- The following attributes will now synchronize to the Target:
 - Ms-DS-ConsistencyGUID (binary)
 - Ms-Mcs-AdmPwd (Microsoft LAPS attribute)
 - Ms-Mcs-AdmPwdExpirationTime (Microsoft LAPS attribute)(39281)
- An issue when synchronizing Group membership after the Source member object is renamed has been resolved. (43663)
- An issue where a Domino user belonging to a Group is synced to AD and then deleted from the Domino Source and the user is not removed from the Group on the AD Target has been resolved. (43836)
